### **What type of pageant is this?**

The Queen Victoria Pageant is a **natural** scholarship pageant held to select representatives for the Victoria Livestock Show. We stress age appropriate make-up, hairstyles and wardrobe.

### **What do I need to do to enter the 2012 Queen Victoria Pageant?**

This document includes all of the forms that must be completed to enter the pageant. Complete a Contestant Information Form and turn it in to the Pageant Director and you will be provided with Sponsor Appreciation Certificates (Sponsor Cards) to give to your sponsors. Turn in all required items by the deadline to finalize your entry.

### **What does it cost to enter the pageant?**

A total of \$200 is required to enter the pageant, however there are credits available for turning in the minimum entry requirements by the early entry deadline and for recruiting other contestants for this year's pageant.

### **Do you offer any guidance or assistance programs to help with the cost to enter the pageant?**

Yes, we want everyone to participate in the pageant that is interested and eligible. Approved fundraising options are:

- ☆ Ask family members, friends or companies and their employees to sponsor you. You will receive Sponsor Cards to give to any of your sponsors that contribute \$25 or more. Please refer to the Fundraising Competitions section below for different sponsorship levels and the benefits that you can offer to prospective sponsors.
- ☆ Use the sample Sponsorship Request Letters included in the Contestant Handbook to create personalized requests to potential sponsors.
- ☆ Accept sponsors for less than \$25 and provide them with a special thank you after the pageant to let them know how you did. An example is included in the Contestant Handbook.
- ☆ Help us recruit other contestants for any of the competition categories and receive a **\$25 credit** for each contestant that enters the pageant that you refer to us. They need to list you in the blank on the Contestant Entry Form where it asks how they heard about the pageant.
- ☆ Turn in all required items by the early entry deadline and receive a **\$25 credit**. A checklist is included in the forms that follow to help you make sure that all items are turned in by the deadline.

Past pageant contestants will also be invited to offer their pageant attire for sale to help reduce current contestant's pageant related expenses.

### **Are there any other fees that I will need to pay?**

There are NO other REQUIRED fees. However, there is a fee of \$25 to enter the optional Photogenic Competition. We will also provide you with the option to purchase a photo CD or DVD video of the pageant from our official pageant photographer and videographer.

### **What will I receive as a pageant contestant?**

All Contestants will be pictured in the program book within their competition category and will receive a souvenir program book. Contestants will also receive a participation certificate and pageant t-shirt. Additional gifts may be awarded to contestants, if available. Contestant photos and information will also be provided in a press release to the local newspaper.

### **What information is included in the Queen Victoria Pageant Contestant Handbook?**

We've attempted to include clear, detailed information about participation in our pageant and the obligations of Queen Victoria Court members. It includes detailed information outlining what will occur in each of the competition areas, what the judges will be instructed to look for when determining scores for each contestant in the competition areas so you can plan accordingly. We've tried to anticipate questions that contestants might ask when preparing for our pageant and have included answers to those questions.

*The contestant handbook is currently being revised to reflect changes to our pageant necessitated by the change in location of this year's pageant. Copies will be emailed to prospective contestants upon completion.*

## PAGEANT REQUIREMENTS

**Opening Number:** The opening number has been deleted from our program this year to reduce the length of the pageant, provide more time for contestants to prepare instead of attending dance rehearsals, and to reduce the stress for those contestants that do not have dance experience.

**Contestant Interviews:** Private interviews for the Queen, Junior Queen and Young Queen contestants will be held the day of the pageant in the VISD Fine Arts Center Annex (next door to Fine Arts Center). During the interviews, the contestants will be asked questions tailored to the individual and that are age appropriate. Judges will be provided a copy of the Contestant Profile Form for their use during the interviews.

Contestants entered in the Cowgirl Tot, Cowboy Tot, Little Miss Cowgirl and Little Mr. Cowboy will be interviewed on-stage during the Western Wear Competition using pre-determined questions tailored to the individual based upon information in the Contestant Profile Form.

**Western Wear:** Each contestant should wear a **western** outfit/dress that fits their personality and physique. Queen, Junior Queen and Young Queen contestants will provide a brief introduction of themselves not to exceed 30 seconds while on stage. Cowgirl Tot, Cowboy Tot, Little Miss Cowgirl and Little Mr. Cowboy will be interviewed on-stage during the Western Wear Competition

**Formal Wear:** **Cowboy Tot and Little Mister Cowboy** contestants should wear a tuxedo, suit or dressy western outfit (slacks, vest or jacket, tie or bolo tie). **Cowgirl Tot and Little Miss Cowgirl** contestants may wear a tea, ballerina or floor length formal dress. **Young Queen, Junior Queen and Queen** contestants' must wear an age appropriate floor length formal, however a "pageant gown" is not necessary. Focus on dresses that enhance your natural beauty and are age appropriate. The dress style should complement your figure and fit well, in a color that goes well with your complexion.

**On-Stage Interview Question:** Contestants in the Queen, Junior Queen and Young Queen competition categories should be prepared to answer an age appropriate question on stage. The question will be the same for all contestants in a competition category, while the other contestants in their category are sequestered in an area so they cannot hear the other contestant's answers. After the entry deadline a decision will be made for each category whether finalists will be selected or if all contestants will be asked the question.

## OTHER COMPETITIONS

**Congeniality Contest:** All contestants will automatically be entered in this competition at no extra charge. Contestants will vote for one individual in each competition category that they feel is most congenial. Winner will receive a bouquet and commemorative keepsake box.

**Fundraising Competition:** Participation in this competition is optional and free to enter. To be eligible Contestant's must raise \$175 over the entry fee from sponsors to be eligible for this competition. Each sponsor contributing \$25 or more will receive a sponsor card to display at their business and be recognized in the pageant program. Please refer to the sponsorship levels below for other sponsor benefits based upon their level of contribution. Each contestant that meets the \$175 fundraising minimum will be recognized based upon the fundraising level they achieved. Special awards will be given to the highest fundraiser in each competition category and the top overall fundraiser will be crowned Princess or Prince Victoria and serve as a member of the Queen Victoria Court during the upcoming year.

**Queen Victoria Sweetheart Awards**

The contestant in each competition category division who raises the most financial support (minimum of \$175.00 over the entry fee) will receive the Queen Victoria Sweetheart award for their competition category during the pageant. They will receive a bouquet, trophy, special gift, two (2) reserved seat tickets for the pageant and will be included in press release to the newspaper.

**Princess or Prince Victoria (Overall Top Fundraiser)**

The contestant that raises the most financial support, (over the entry fees) from businesses, family, and friends, regardless of pageant competition category will be crowned our Princess or Prince Victoria during our coronation ceremony. They will become a member of the Queen Victoria Court for the upcoming year, receive a tiara (girl) or buckle (boy), sash, bouquet, assorted sponsored gifts (as available) and will be included in the press release to the local newspaper.

**People’s Choice Competition:** This competition is optional and there is no fee to enter. Contestants that wish to participate will need to decorate a container that will be used as a ballot box to collect “votes”, equal to \$1 each, from friends and family members prior to and during the pageant, until intermission. The contestant, in each competition category, that receives the most votes will win a beautiful trophy and rhinestone scepter!

**Photogenic Contest:** All contestants are eligible to enter this optional competition however there is an entry fee. Contestants must submit a printed 5” x 7” color or black and white photo of their choice with a completed Photogenic Competition Entry Form and \$25 entry fee no later than January 28, 2011 to enter this competition. Contestants may enter more than once, but must complete an entry form and pay the fee for each photo entered. Judges will select one winner for each competition category prior to the pageant and the winners will receive a bouquet and personalized commemorative photo frame with their winning picture inserted.

## **QUEEN VICTORIA COURT EXPENSES**

We make every effort possible to keep court expenses to a minimum. However, the court represents and promotes the Victoria Livestock Show throughout the year so specific attire will be designated for members. Parade attire, which must coordinate with the float theme, and shirts for casual community service activities will be decided on at the first court meeting with final approval by the Court Activities Coordinator. Court members will be required to have a black felt cowboy hat, black boots and black belt. Western attire will be required during the Victoria Livestock Show. Formal attire is required for the lighted Christmas parades, the dress color will be white for the girls and the boys will wear black suits or tuxedos.

Each court member will also be asked to bring snacks and drinks to one of the parades we attend.

## 2012 Queen Victoria Rules and Regulations

### *Please Read this Page Carefully Before Signing*

1. I am or will be between the ages of 4-18 years old as of February 11, 2012. I am of good health and moral character. I am not married, nor have I ever been married. I am not currently pregnant, nor have I ever given birth to any children.
  2. If under the age of 18, I will not attend any pageant functions or court activities without my parent or legally responsible adult chaperone present.
  3. I presently reside and will continue to reside in Victoria County during the year of my reign.
  4. Contestants cannot be related to, by blood or adoption, to the Pageant Chair or Co-Chair within the first degree of consanguinity (i.e. mother or father) or within the second degree (i.e. grandparents, grandchildren, uncle, aunt, first cousin, nephew, niece, brother, sister). Relatives of other pageant committee members and Victoria Livestock Show volunteers are eligible to compete.
  5. Former Queen Victoria Court title winners members are welcome to compete in the pageant, but cannot compete in a category if they were previously a title winner. They must move up to the next older competition category and may do so before they reach the minimum age for that category if they chose to do so. All other contestants must compete in the appropriate competition category based upon their age on January 22, 2012.
  6. I verify that I have not and will not engage in any activities which would bring, or tend to bring myself, the pageant or my court, into disrepute, ridicule, or contempt. This includes but is not limited to, inappropriate internet or social networking behavior, use of alcohol or illegal drugs, any other illegal behavior, any felony conviction, probation or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
  7. I understand that good sportsmanship is required and that I must be respectful of others at all times. Contestants, or any individual with a relationship to a contestant, must not approach Judges with the intent to influence or harass. Action of this type will be reported by the judge to the Queen Victoria Pageant Director and may result in loss of title and/or being banned from future pageant participation.
  8. I understand that to participate in the pageant and to be an active participant on the court, I must maintain passing status, 70 or above, in all classes. I will provide a copy of each report card I receive to the Court Coordinator as soon as possible after receipt. To be re-instated as an active participant on the court I must provide evidence of passing status to the Court Coordinator.
  9. I understand that any photographs/videos of contestants during the pageant and of the court throughout the year by pageant officials or their designees, will become the property of the Victoria Livestock Show and may be used for Victoria Livestock Show related marketing materials without further permission.
- If I am selected as a member of the Queen Victoria Court:
10. I will not participate in any other pageants without the permission of the Pageant Director/Court Coordinator. I understand that if I choose to compete in any other pageant, and win a title in that pageant, that my first obligation is to the Victoria Livestock Show Queen Victoria Court, and if I choose to represent the other pageant I will forfeit my current title and awards.
  11. I will not wear my tiara, banner, or court wardrobe unless at or on my way to/from an approved function unless I have received prior approval from the Court Coordinator. I will not have any visible tattoos or body piercing while at functions or appearances.
  12. I agree to be available for the full term of one (1) year, understand that attendance is expected at designated events and activities, and that three (3) consecutive unexcused absences or excessive non-participation in court activities may result in loss of title.
  13. If I cannot fulfill the expressed duties, I will immediately relinquish my title, tiara or buckle, sash and all prizes and/or scholarships upon the direction of the Victoria Livestock Show Queen Victoria Pageant Director, Queen Victoria Court Coordinator or Victoria Livestock Show Management. The first runner-up must be willing and able to assume all duties in the event that the winner is unable or unwilling to fulfill her/his reign.
  14. I understand that if I violate any rule set forth, conduct myself in a manner unbecoming of a queen and representative of the Victoria Livestock Show, fail to adhere to the Court Coordinator's instructions, or nonconformity to the group from winners, runner-ups, or parents could result in disciplinary action which may include termination of my title, relinquishment of my tiara or buckle, and sash, and forfeiture of all prizes and/or scholarships. I also understand that if I am terminated I may also be banned from future Queen Victoria Pageant participation.
